A public Information Meeting is to be held on September 18, 2014 in the conference room at the above listed site location for the purpose of reviewing the application for a permit revision. The Riverside County Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. The Moreno Valley Solid Waste Recycling and Transfer Facility, operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit issued by the LEA. The operator has filed an application for a Permit Revision with the LEA. The Permit Revision describes the design and operation of the facility.

As required by 27 CCR, Section 21660.1, the LEA is distributing this notice for the purpose of noticing its acceptance of the Permit Revision for Moreno Valley Solid Waste Recycling and Transfer Facility.

Description of Project

The Permit Revision addresses the following changes:

1. Revise the boundaries of the site and expand the size by 5 acres from 19.89 acres to 24.89 acres
2. Clarify hours of operation in conformance with CEQA and local planning as:
 - a. Administrative Operations: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday – Friday
 - b. Transfer Station Operations: 24 hours/day Monday-Sunday
 - c. Material Recovery Processing: 24 hours/day Monday-Sunday
 - d. Maintenance: 24 hours/day Monday-Sunday

LEA's Determination

An application for a Permit Revision was received by the LEA on June 30, 2014. Pursuant to 27 CCR, Section 21665(c), the LEA reviewed the application and determined that the proposed change is consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards and does not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP.
