Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the Report of Facility Information (RFI) for the Inland Regional Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The Inland Regional Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station is located at 2059 East Steel Road, Colton CA 92324. On March 25, 2014 the LEA received, from the operator of Inland Regional Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the Report of Facility Information (RFI). This amendment was submitted to update the table of contents, language, and figures of the RFI due to changes in the design of the facility. The operator replaced the portable office and scale house trailers with a 3,000 square foot building; and installed a bio-retention basin (west corner of the property), a subsurface infiltration (at the location of the former office trailers), and a cattle guard at the exit driveway. Also, the changes to the design include two new canopies, but these canopies will be installed by October 2014. No other change to the RFI is under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, State Minimum Standards, and do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA approved the amendment on April 22, 2014.
