Decision Subject: Issuance of Proposed Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Bertolotti Transfer Station & Recycling Center, SWIS No. 50-AA-0013 and Adoption of Negative Declaration, SCH No. 2011082025

Action By: November 19, 2011

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed revised Solid Waste Facilities Permit and adopt Negative Declaration, SCH No. 2011082025, for the Bertolotti Transfer Station & Recycling Center, SWIS No. 50-AA-0013, located in Stanislaus County. The Department serves as the Enforcement Agency in this jurisdiction and was the lead agency in the CEQA process. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The application for the permit revision was received on September 19, 2011. A proposed permit was finalized on October 10, 2011. Action must be taken on the proposed permit no later than November 19, 2011. If no action is taken by November 19, 2011, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

The Department, acting as Lead Agency prepared and circulated a Negative Declaration (ND) State Clearinghouse No. 2011082025 for a thirty day review period beginning on August 9, 2011 and ending on September 7, 2011. No agency or public comments were received. A Notice of Completion (NOC) was filed with the State Clearinghouse on August 8, 2011.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staffs recommends the Branch Chief issue the permit and adopt the Negative Declaration. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action:

On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report, I concur in the issuance of the Revised Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit and in the adoption of the Negative Declaration for the Bertolotti Transfer Station and Recycling Center as proposed.
