**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Teapot Dome Disposal Site, SWIS No. 54-AA-0004, located in Tulare County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on May 6, 2016. A new proposed permit was received on June 8, 2016. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than August 7, 2016. If no action is taken by August 7, 2016, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

**Recommendation:** Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report.
