

**Summary of Request:** This is a request that the Deputy Director take action on a proposed New Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Central Transfer/Processing Facility, SWIS No. 49-AA-0404, located in Sonoma County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was initially received on November 10, 2011. A new version of the proposed permit was received on December 13, 2011. Action must be taken on this proposed permit no later than February 11, 2012. If no action is taken by February 11, 2012 the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

**Recommendation:** Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Deputy Director concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 14, Section 18105.5 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting & Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Staff Report.
