

Decision Subject: Concurrence on Proposed New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Harvest-Lathrop, San Joaquin County, SWIS No. 39-AA-0051

Action By: September 15, 2012

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief take action on a proposed Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Harvest-Lathrop, SWIS No. 39-AA-0051, located in San Joaquin County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was originally received on June 18, 2012. A new version of the proposed permit was received on July 17, 2012. Action must be taken on this permit no later than September 15, 2012. If no action is taken by September 15, 2012, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed new SWFP.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Branch Chief concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the table found in the Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the attached Permitting and Assistance Branch Staff Report.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information and analysis in this Request for Action and the findings set out in the Permitting & Assistance staff report, I concur in the issuance of the New Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Harvest-Lathrop, SWIS No. 39-AA-0051, as proposed.
