**SUBJECT: RSL Operating, Inc. – Issuance of New Solid Waste Facility Permit,
Facility No. 39-AA-0056**

Dear Mr. Baldwin:

On April 25, 2016, the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), as the Enforcement Agency for the City of Stockton, issued a New Solid Waste Facilities Permit (SWFP) for RSL Operating, Inc., Facility Number 39-AA-0056, to operate a large volume transfer/processing facility. The issued SWFP is enclosed.

As previously mentioned to representatives of RSL Operating, Inc., since CalRecycle is currently serving as the solid waste enforcement agency for the City of Stockton, CalRecycle is authorized to charge reasonable fees to recover operation costs, pursuant to Public Resources Code, Sections 43212 and 43310.1. CalRecycle recovers costs for time spent on duties such as inspections, reviewing pertinent documentation, permit writing and review, consultation, travel, per diem, etc. The current billing rate is \$110.35 per hour. A billing invoice is compiled each fiscal-year quarter and sent to the operator.

CalRecycle staff will conduct random unannounced inspections of the facility on a monthly basis to evaluate compliance with the terms and conditions of the SWFP and State Minimum Standards contained in Title 14, California Code of Regulation, Chapter 3, Articles 6.0, 6.1, 6.2, 6.3 and 6.35 (<http://www.calrecycle.ca.gov/Laws/Regulations/Title14/ch3a6.htm#c3a6>).

The issuance of the SWFP does not relieve RSL Operating, Inc. from obtaining all required local, state, or federal permits, licenses, or other clearances and complying with all orders, laws, regulations, or reports, or other requirements of other regulatory agencies.
