Action By: October 30, 2010

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Program Director take action on a proposed Modified Solid Waste Facilities Permit for Monofill Facility, SWIS No. 13-AA-0022, located in Imperial County. Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.

The proposed permit was received on July 16, 2010. Two different versions of the permit were received, most recently on August 31, 2010. Action must be taken on this permit no later than October 30, 2010. If no action is taken by October 30, 2010, the Department will be deemed to have concurred with the issuance of the proposed permit.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit package, staff recommends the Program Director concur with the issuance of the permit. All of the required submittals and findings required by Title 27, Section 21685 have been made and the required CEQA findings have been made in support of concurrence. These findings are summarized in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report attachment. The documents on which staff's findings are based are located in the facility files. Details on the findings are presented in more detail in the Waste Compliance and Mitigation Program Staff Report.

Program Director Action: On the basis of the information, analysis and findings in the staff report attached to this Request for Action and staff recommendation, I hereby concur in the issuance of the proposed Modified Full Solid Waste Facilities Permit for the Monofill Facility site.
