NOTICE OF HEARING


(Pursuant to Government Code Section 11509)

18 TO THE RESPONDENT, CALIFORNIA TIRE RECOVERY, LLC. You are hereby
19 notified that before an Administrative Law Judge a trial shall be held on **June 27, 2013**
20 **at 9:00 a.m. at the Office of Administrative Hearings, 1350 Front Street, Suite**
21 **3005, San Diego, California 92101**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard,
22 upon the charges made in the Statement of Issues for the Denial of the Minor Waste
23 Tire Facility Permit served upon you. If you object to the place of hearing, you must
24 notify the presiding officer within 10 days after this notice is served on you. Failure to
25 notify the presiding officer within 10 days will deprive you of a change in the place of the
26 hearing. You may be present at the hearing. You have the right to be represented by
27 an attorney at your own expense. You are not entitled to the appointment of an attorney
28 to represent you at public expense. You are entitled to represent yourself without legal

1 counsel. You may present any relevant evidence, and will be given full opportunity to
2 cross-examine witnesses testifying at hearing against you. You are entitled to the
3 issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of
4 books, documents, or other things by applying to the Office of Administrative Hearings,
5 1350 Front Street, Suite 3005, San Diego, California 92101. Pursuant to section 11513
6 of the Government Code, parties are entitled, upon request, to be provided with the
7 assistance of an interpreter if they do not proficiently speak or understand the English
8 language. If you require the assistance of an interpreter; timely notice of this fact should
9 be given to the agency conducting the hearing so that appropriate arrangements can be
10 made.

11 CONTINUANCES: Continuances are not favored. If you need a continuance,
12 write or call immediately to the Office of Administrative Hearings, 1350 Front Street,
13 Suite 3005, San Diego, California 92101 (619) 525-4475. That agency has control of
14 continuances. Requests coming less than 30 days before hearing, or a request without
15 good cause, will be denied.
