

Decision Subject: Issuance of a Major Waste Tire Facility Permit Renewal for Tri-C Manufacturing Inc.,
TPID No. 1480835/57-TI-1112

Action By: October 15, 2014

Summary of Request: This is a request that the Branch Chief approve the issuance of a Major Waste Tire Facility Permit (WTFP) for Tri-C Manufacturing Inc., TPID No. 1480835/57-TI-1112, in West Sacramento (Yolo County). Staff's findings and recommendations are provided relative to the proposed action.


Staff received an application for a Major Waste Tire Facility Permit renewal on March 21, 2014. The application was accepted on April 18, 2014. Based upon the acceptance of the application, CalRecycle is required to act by October 15, 2014. The existing major WTFP expires on March 23, 2015.

The existing 2010 WTFP allows for a maximum capacity of 10,000 whole waste tires and/or waste tire equivalents on-site. The operator proposes no change to the current site design/operation.

Recommendation: Based on our review of the submitted permit application package, staff recommends issuance of the Major WTFP. The applicant has met all the necessary application requirements outlined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 18431 pertaining to the issuance of a Major WTFP renewal. The documents and analysis on which staff's findings are based are permanently maintained by the Waste Permitting, Compliance, and Mitigation Division.

Branch Chief Action: On the basis of the information, analysis and findings in the staff report attached to this Request for Action and staff recommendation, I hereby issue the Major Waste Tire Facility Permit for Tri-C Manufacturing Inc., TPID No. 1480835/57-TI-1112.
