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
CalRecycle's Responsibilities under AB 1343

- Review and approve stewardship plans
 - Approve architectural paint stewardship assessment
- Post list of compliant manufacturers online
- Review annual reports
- Enforce the statute

Scope of Proposed Regulation

- Establish criteria for:
 - stewardship plan approval
 - acceptance of annual reports
- Penalty ranges that reflect a progressive enforcement approach; and
- Administrative process for service payments to CalRecycle


Overview of Regulatory Timeline
