

Photo Report City of Downey 2/14/12 - 2/15/12

A) Commercial Diversion Program

The City has changed its commercial waste routing into “wet” garbage routes and “dry” garbage routes; the “wet” garbage routes collect wet waste that would contaminate the recyclables in the “dry” garbage routes.



This was an average “dry” garbage load. Although the load contained some greenwaste, this did not significantly contaminate the available recyclables. This load was consistent with the hauler’s estimates that it has recently been recovering 30 to 40 percent of the “dry” garbage routes.

A) Commercial Diversion Program (cont'd)



As an average “wet” load, this load had less potential for recovery. However, it contained pockets of recoverable materials such as cardboard, suggesting the need for continued refinement of the City’s “wet” and “dry” routing.

B) Construction and Demolition (C&D) Diversion Program



This entire C&D load went to the processing facility's C&D recovery pile.
