Dear Mr. Pomaville:

I have received and considered your agency's October 21, 2014 request to extend the compliance schedule by an additional twelve months beyond the extended compliance date previously granted by the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the American Avenue Landfill, a facility on the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate Statement Minimum Standards (Inventory). I recognize the progress made towards compliance to date and acknowledge that extenuating circumstances will require additional time to replace a number of gas collection wells.

I hereby approve your request for the extension of the compliance schedule until October 13, 2015.
