**SUBJECT: Approval for a 4<sup>th</sup> Extension of the Compliance Schedule for the West Central Landfill, Facility No. 45-AA-0043, Shasta County**

Dear Ms. Serio:

I have received and considered your agency's March 20, 2015 request to extend the compliance schedule by an additional twelve months beyond the one year period previously granted by the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for the West Central Landfill, a facility on the Inventory of Solid Waste Facilities Which Violate Statement Minimum Standards. Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 18365 provides that CalRecycle may grant an extension(s) beyond the two years of the facility's inclusion on the Inventory.

CalRecycle acknowledges that the operator's revised Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) to expand its permitted boundary was recently approved by CalRecycle. Therefore, CalRecycle is agreeing to extend the order to March 26, 2016 with the condition that two milestones are completed.

- By October 26, 2015, the perimeter monitoring probes proposed to replace MP-2 shall be installed in the expanded boundary and in compliance with Title 27, CCR, Section 20921- 20939.
- By March 26, 2016, all perimeter gas monitoring compliance probes, including MP-4, MP-11, and the MP-2 replacement wells, will be in compliance with Title 27 CCR, Section 20921.

Future extensions will not be granted without a demonstration of significant good faith effort and extenuating circumstances, and a submittal of a new remediation plan.
