The Sacramento County Environmental Management Department is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) to act as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) within the cities and county of Sacramento, enforcing state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities.

Purpose of the meetings

The LEA will be holding two informational public meetings in compliance with AB 1497 and Public Resource Code 44004 regarding a proposed new Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Florin Perkins Disposal Site Material Recovery Facility/Large Volume Transfer Station (MRF/TS). A summary of public comments from the informational meetings and any written comments received by the LEA will be included with the approved permit application package that will be submitted to the CIWMB for concurrence at a public meeting. If you wish to be notified of the CIWMB meeting, please notify the LEA in writing no later than March 12, 2008.

Project Description and the LEA preliminary determination

The Project Applicant, Zanker Road Resource Management, Ltd. seeks to operate a MRF/TS on the same 10 acre footprint at 4201 Florin Perkins Road, as the former operator, Florin Perkins Landfill, Inc., for the purpose of processing and recycling construction and demolition debris and inert materials. The operational area of the proposed MRF/TS will encompass the same 2.5 acres of the 10 acre, previously permitted, site (APN 061-0150-042). The LEA accepted the application as complete and correct on December 28, 2007. The proposed permit is to allow the design and operations of a new facility as follows:

- **Type of wastes to be accepted:** Construction and demolition waste, commercial and non-hazardous waste (i.e. debris box wastes), non-putrescible household refuse and debris. Note: Operator will be permitted to receive no more than 4% putrescible waste on a daily basis by weight.
- **Maximum tonnage:** 500 tons per day (TPD). Note: Initial tonnage will be limited to a peak of 250 TPD. Incremental increases in tonnage over time will be subject to LEA approval and will be based upon performance measures established by the LEA.
- **Traffic volume:** 233 (counted one way)
- **Hours of operation:** Receipt of waste and ancillary operations are limited to the hours of 6am - 6pm, Sunday through Saturday.
