This meeting is for all interested parties to provide comments on the proposed revision to the Solid Waste Facility Permit for Redwood Landfill. Interested parties can ask questions and provide comments. Comments may be submitted prior to the meeting, directly to Ms. Ng at the above address and email, or by fax. No decisions will be made at this meeting.

Proposed changes to landfill operations that required a permit revision are:

- The compost permit and the landfill permit will be combined into one permit;
- A decrease in tonnage of green waste and biosolids to be composted, from 545 to 170 tons (tpd) total material. However, food waste will be added as a compost feed stock;
- Additional tonnage for receipt of material for recovery/recycling – 400 tpd;
- A reduction in the amount of biosolids received – from 1,000 to 230 tpd;
- An increase in landfill capacity to 26,077,000 cubic yards of waste and cover material, including final cover.

On October 23, 2008, the Solid Waste Facility Permit revision application was accepted by the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA). A proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit, a Draft Mitigation Monitoring Report Program (MMRP), and an explanation of the Draft MMRP are available on the Marin County Environmental Health Services website, www.co.marin.ca.us/ehs. Any appeal will be processed in accordance and pursuant to Public Resource Code sections 44307 and 44310(PRC §44307). Appeals can only be made after the decision to issue or deny the permit has occurred.
