PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Section 21660.2 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be conducting an informational meeting on a proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Harris Road LLC Material Recovery Facility and Transfer Station.

Purpose: The meeting is being held to provide information about a proposed transfer/processing facility to be operated by Merced County Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division. The public will be offered the opportunity to ask the LEA and Operator questions about the application package that was accepted for filing on November 16th, 2009 and the permitting process for a full solid waste facility permit. A summary of comments from the informational meeting and any written comments received by the LEA prior to the meeting will be included with the permit application package submitted to the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) for concurrence at a public meeting to be held at a later date.

Project Description: The project applicant, Merced County Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, seeks to operate a processing facility and transfer station that will accept municipal solid waste generated within but not limited to the Cities of Dos Palos, Gustine, and Los Banos. . The initial operation area will encompass 4.9 acres at the existing 172 acre Billy Wright Landfill Site.

- **Maximum tonnage:** 1,500 tons per day
- **Traffic volume:** 630 vehicle trips Landfill & Transfer Station
- **Permitted hours of operation:** 24 hours per day, 7 days per week
