Proposed New Solid Waste Facility Permit for Harris Road LLC Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Section 21660.2 of Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations, that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be conducting an informational meeting on a proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Harris Road LLC Material Recovery Facility and Transfer Station.

Purpose: The meeting is being held to provide information about a proposed material recovery facility and transfer station to be operated by Palo Verde Valley Disposal Services. The public will be offered the opportunity to ask the LEA questions about the application package that was accepted for filing on March 10, 2009 and the permitting process for a full solid waste facility permit. A summary of comments from the informational meeting and any written comments received by the LEA prior to the meeting will be included with the permit application package submitted to the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) for concurrence at a public meeting to be held at a later date.

Project: Harris Road LLC Material Recovery Facility & Transfer Station
194 E. Harris Road, Imperial, CA
(Located approximately 0.25 miles west of Highway 111 on Harris Road)

Project Description: The project applicant, Harris Road LLC, seeks to operate a material recovery facility and transfer station that will be accepting municipal solid waste, construction and demolition waste, waste tires, green and wood waste, inert waste, source separated recyclables, e-waste, and universal waste. Waste entering the site will be sorted for recyclable material and the residual waste will be transferred to an off-site permitted landfill for disposal. The initial operation area will encompass 13.9 acres of a 25-acre parcel.

- **Maximum tonnage:** 1,500 tons per day
- **Traffic volume:** 500 vehicle trips (one-way inbound)
- **Permitted hours of operation:** 24 hours per day, 7 days per week
- **Proposed hours of operation:** Monday – Friday
6 A.M. to 6 P.M.

Saturday 6 A.M. to 4 P.M.
(Closed Sundays and Holidays)
