NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

MADERA COUNTY RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AS THE LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY (LEA)

As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Information Meeting in compliance with Public Resources Code Section 44004 for the issuance of a full Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Madera County Fairmead Landfill and Mammoth MRF/Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resource Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Madera.

Description of Project

The County of Madera LEA received a Solid Waste Facility Permit SWFP application package for the Fairmead Landfill on March 9, 2010. On April 8, 2010, the LEA accepted the application package as complete. The Fairmead Landfill is proposing a vertical expansion from 325 feet to 370 feet and the commercial tipping/operational hours will increase (1 hour) to 6:00 am to 7:00 pm Monday through Friday. On April 19, 2010 the Mammoth MRF Transfer Station submitted a Certification of No Change. The Fairmead Landfill and Mammoth MRF Transfer Station are both located at 21739 Road 19, in Chowchilla, California.

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Information Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action. **The County of Madera LEA will hold this informational meeting on Wednesday, MAY 5, 2010, at 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm, located at the Madera County Resource Management Agency, 2037 W. Cleveland Ave, Madera, California.**

Options for Submitting Comments and LeA Contact Information

The County of Madera LEA will consider all comments, written or oral, before making its final determination on the application packages.
