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As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Information Meeting in compliance with Public Resources Code Section 44004 for the issuance of a full Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill Organic Materials Processing Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of

Resource Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Contra Costa, including all transfer, processing, and compost facilities.

Description of Project

West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill Organic Materials Processing Facility, Facility #07-AA-0044, is a transfer station/composting facility located at 1 Parr Boulevard, Richmond, California. The facility is currently operating under a green waste chipping and grinding Notification Tier. The proposed expanded operations and composting will be permitted as a transfer station due to the amount of contamination expected in the materials received. The planned composting of biosolids as one of the feedstock requires a full permit be issued.

On December 22, 2009, the LEA received a permit application package for review from West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill, Inc. (WCCSL, Inc.) for an expanded compost facility. On January 20, 2010, the LEA accepted the application package as complete and correct.

The LEA finds that the proposed project is consistent with the state minimum standards, the County Integrated Waste Management Plan, and the facility's July 2004 Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and December 2008 EIR Addendum.

The LEA must submit a proposed SWFP to CalRecycle for concurrence within 60 days of acceptance of the application package as complete and correct (March 21, 2010).

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Information Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action. **NO DECISIONS WILL BE MADE AT THIS MEETING.** Prior to issuance of the permit, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from CalRecycle.
