Notice of Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) Application for Selma Disposal Recycling and Transfer Facility

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in compliance with Public Resources Code 44004 and Title 27 California Code of Regulations (CCR), that the County of Fresno, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application on **February 9, 2011** for the Selma Disposal Recycling and Transfer Facility. The facility is located at 1675 Dockery Ave, Selma CA and the SWFP number is 10-AA-0191. The purpose of the informational meeting is to make public the preliminary determination of the action to be taken by the LEA on the SWFP application package.

On **February 9, 2011** the Fresno County Public Health Department, Environmental Health Division, acting as the LEA received a SWFP application package for the Selma Disposal Recycling and Transfer Facility. The SWFP application package was accepted on **March 10, 2011**. The LEA's preliminary determination is that the proposed SWFP application package meets the requirements of Title 27 CCR 21570.

The SWFP application will address the following operations:

- Maximum of 400 tons per day of incoming municipal solid waste
- Facility operating 24 hours (receiving wastes 5:00am to 8:00pm), Monday through Saturday
- Acceptable and non-acceptable materials
- Maximum of 126 incoming vehicles per day
- Processing and Storage of solid waste materials
- Facility boundary 7.8 acres of a 21.6 acre parcel

A copy of the SWFP application package is on file and available for public review from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Fresno County Department of Public Health, Environmental Health Division, located at 1221 Fulton Mall, Fresno CA 93721. The informational meeting will take place on **Monday April 4, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. at the City of Selma, City Hall Board Room located at 1710 Tucker Street**.
