NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING
PUBLIC INPUT REQUESTED FOR THE
ADVANCE DISPOSAL MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY (MRF)
SOLID WASTE FACILITY PERMIT REVISION (Facility Number 36-AA-0337)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, April 3, 2012 at 5:30 pm., the County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Services, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will conduct a public informational meeting pursuant to Public Resources Code 44004 to receive public input from interested parties regarding the upgrade and expansion of the existing Advance Disposal Material Recovery Facility (MRF) which will include the following:

- Name change from Advance Disposal Material Recovery Facility to Advance Disposal Center For The Environment
- Increasing the permitted tonnage to 1,500 tons per day (TPD), from 600 TPD.
- Increasing the permitted traffic volume to 387 vehicles per day (VPD), from 217 VPD
- Construction of a new receiving/processing building of approximately 64,500 square feet, for a total MRF footprint of 123,000 square feet.
- Enclosure of all processing activities including MRF sorting municipal solid waste (MSW), green waste chipping and grinding, and C&D debris sorting and recycling.
- New scales and internal traffic circulation.
- New transfer truck load out featuring a two-lane transfer tunnel for efficient top loading.
- Additional driveways for ease of traffic circulation.
- Storage of roll-offs and containers on the new east parcel on paved surface.
- Improved frontage along new parcels: landscaping, sidewalk, curb and gutter, widened and paved street.
- New paved truck parking area,
- Storm water retention and treatment

SAID MEETING will be conducted at the Advance Disposal Facility at 17105 Mesa Street, Hesperia, California 92345 where members of the public may be present and heard on this matter. The LEA's preliminary determination is that the SWFP be revised to incorporate the proposed changes. A copy of the application can be obtained by contacting the LEA during regular business hours. The LEA will receive and consider the statements from the public pertaining to this permit revision. All written or verbal comments will be considered when the LEA makes a determination to process the permit revision. The decision to issue or not to issue the revised SWFP must be made by the LEA within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete as required by Statute. Prior to issuance of the revised SWFP, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from the California Department of Resources Recycling & Recovery (CalRecycle).
