The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program, acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a Public Informational Meeting for a permit revision for Lancaster Landfill and Recycling Center. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within Los Angeles County.

Description of Project

Revision of the facility's joint technical document to incorporate the following proposed changes:

- Increase in municipal solid waste daily tonnage from 1,700 tons per day (TPD) to 3,000 TPD.
- Tonnage increase for inert debris and beneficial use materials from 1,600 TPD to 2,100 TPD.
- Increase in traffic associated with tonnage increases.
- Correction of the total permitted refuse footprint from 209 acres to 210.3 acres.
- Revision of the groundwater monitoring frequency.

Purpose of the Meeting

This Public Informational Meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the permit revision and to provide comments to the LEA. The meeting is strictly informational and **no official decision will be made at the meeting** regarding the formal determination on the solid waste facility permit application.
