Introduction

Please be advised that the County of Sacramento Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment to the Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for K&M Recycling. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County and City of Sacramento.

Description of project and LEA's determination

K&M Recycling is a 12-acre site where wood processing activities have taken place since the 1970's. K&M Recycling has operated the site since 1995. The site is located at 3562 Ramona Avenue, south of Folsom Boulevard and west of Power Inn Road, Sacramento, CA 95833. On June 22, 2007 the LEA

received from K&M Recycling, a SWFP application package to amend the RFI requesting to revise the document to:

- Update contact information
- Change the location of the processing equipment during different times of the year within the currently designated (site plan) processing areas

No other change to the SWFP is under consideration at this time. The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with the California Integrated Waste Management Board State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facilities Permit. The facility has Categorical Exemption-15301, Class 1 with the California Environmental Quality Act. The LEA approved the amendment on July 16, 2007.
