As a property owner, tenant or person with vested interest in the project vicinity, please be advised that the County of Monterey Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has accepted an RFI amendment application package from USA Waste of California, Inc., for the Salinas Disposal Transfer Station and Recycling Center in Salinas, CA. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Monterey, including all solid waste disposal facilities.

Description of Project

On June 12, 2008, the LEA received a RFI Amendment application package from USA Waste of California, Inc., regarding the Salinas Disposal Transfer Station and Recycling Center at 1120 Madison Lane in Salinas, CA. The purpose of the application package was to enact several improvements at the facility, including re-paving the site and renovating office buildings.

In addition, the operator has requested to park empty solid and liquid waste hauling vehicles at the facility for overnight storage and repair. This will also include renovation of an existing building for a more appropriate vehicle maintenance facility. No structures will be added to the facility as a result of this proposal. The total amount of vehicles entering the site, whether they are using the facility or parking, is not to exceed the amount currently permitted in the solid waste facility permit for this site.

Findings

The LEA has determined that:

- The requested amendments do not require a permit revision and may be authorized through a permit amendment.
- The application is accepted, meets the requirements of 27 CCR 21665 (c), and is approved.
- The approved RFI amendment will be incorporated into or replace portions of the existing RFI (September 2005).

Appeals Process Information

Pursuant to Public Resources Code §44307, the decision of the LEA may be challenged through a formal hearing process.
