The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP), acting as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within its jurisdiction. Waste Management South Gate Transfer operates under a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) issued by the SWMP. On **April 03, 2013**, the operator filed an application for amendments to their Report of Facility Information (RFI).

Description of Project

- The facility is proposing to add as part of their daily operation, the addition of product destruction, processing and recycling activities.
- The material will be processed manually either under the canopy covered loading dock near baler or inside the building in a specified area only.
- The recovered material consists of, but is not limited to glass, plastic and cardboard from products received

LEA's Determination

Pursuant to Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665 (c), SWMP reviewed the application and determined that the proposed change is consistent with all adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards and do not conflict with the terms and conditions of the current SWFP. The SWMP approved the RFI amendments on **May 01, 2013**.
