AB 2176 - Purpose

- **Available/convenient recycling for attendees**
- **Encourage local ordinances**
- **Promote waste reduction planning design & operation**
- **Partnerships with community groups**

Definitions

Large Event

- **Charges admission *or* is operated by the jurisdiction**

and

- **More than 2,000 attendees & workers per day of event**

Definitions

Large Venue

- **Permanent facility**
- **Annual average of more than 2,000 attendees and workers per day of operation**



Requirements

- **Large Venues and Large Events**
- **Jurisdictions**
- **Waste Management Board**

Large Venues & Large Events

- **Develop waste reduction plan, goal, and timeline**
- **Implement plan**
- **Report annually to jurisdiction**
- **Update plan every 2 years**



Jurisdictions

- Identify large venues & large events
- Provide information with permits
- Report on top 10%
- May charge a fee





- **Model ordinance**
- **Tools and assistance for venues & events and jurisdictions**
- **Enable reporting via Annual Report**
- **2008: Recommendations to Legislature if < 75% of reporting 10% of venues/events have prepared / implemented plans**

Models

- **One tool specified is model ordinance**
- **Jurisdictions modify model to meet their specific needs**
- **Adoption at local level is voluntary**
